Job Title: Operator HGV - Industrial Services Department.
Reports To: Team Leader, Supervisor, Coordination / Management or Distribution Department.
Location: Based at Fuel Depot Scorrier, outer depots and clients sites around the UK
Hours of work: 40 hours per working week - Permanent position.

About The Role:

The role is for an experienced person who will be at the forefront of our projects operating specialist machinery locally and around the UK.

The primary role will be working for industrial services who own and operate ADR vacuum tankers and Jet vacs used to support our own projects or our clients collecting various types of hazardous waste streams, operators will also cover fuel distribution as part of a pool of relief drivers.

As part of industrial services you will be required to carry our essential services for the project team as and when required working in a variety of commercial and industrial environments, this can be failed fuel tanks, fuel uplifts, emergency spill response, civil installations, ground works and much more, it's key to have a wiliness to learn and to undertake all works in a professional manner.

This operator's role is suited for someone with proven experience or a background within the HGV industry and looking to start full time employment.

Additional training will be provided where you'll be shown skills and techniques by your peers, to also complement your development you'll undergo a selection of training supplied by our third-party providers and time served industry leaders.

Reporting to:

When working for Industrial Services you'll report to your team leader / supervisor / or site / project lead.

When working at the depots you'll be required to report & relaying information back to the distribution team, outer depot tasks will be panned in by the distribution management team.

Home Depot & Outer Depots (Plymouth, Holsworthy & Tiverton) Duties:

- Maintain the Ind Ser & pool vehicle assets, this is to include pre-usage vehicle inspections, defect inspections, planned maintenance, essential repair.

- All Ind Ser vehicle assets are to be visually inspected / restocked and made ready for the next call out or project.
- Ind Ser assets include pumping systems, transfer hoses, confined space, safety equipment and tankers are to be maintained ready for the next callout or project. All equipment to undergo routine maintenance.
- Stocktake of Ind Ser assets.
- To assist with Fuel distribution, commercial workshop, and maintenance department tasks.
- Collect FOD and remove general rubbish.
- Clean and pressure wash company infrastructure.
- Manually collect fuel samples from storage tanks.
- Check fuel storage tank bunds.
- Sample & inspect interceptors.
- Inspect and maintain sites drainage / aco systems.
- Empty slops tanks.
- Clean tank internals as part of planned & preventive maintenance.

Operational Tasks:

- ADR Vacuum Tanker Support - provide ADR Class 3 Vacuum tanker / jet tanker support to our project sites.
- Fuel Distribution - supporting the fuel distribution side of the business to deliver fuels around the southwest and beyond.
- Fuel Uplifting - Removing diesel, kerosene, Jet A1 or petrol from client sites.
- Tank Cleaning - Cleaning of domestic heating oil tanks, confined space entry in commercial tanks.
- Installation works - Installing new fuel storage systems or dispensers, basic civil reinstatement works, ground works.
- Fuel Polishing - Sampling, setting up of mobile fuel filtering systems to bring the clients fuel back into spec.
- Spill Response - Assisting our own distribution business or third party clients with effective spill response and remediation activities.
- Preparedness - Assisting in our continual preparedness for planned works, response and callouts, stock taking, asset management.
- Fuel Depot Support - Assisting with opening and closing the depot, maintenance, stock relocation.

Callout Duties:

- To assist with emergency callouts, spill response, tanker breakdown and recoveries, rollovers and other related incidents nationally.
- Assist with emergency fuel deliveries & fuel uplifts.

Project Duties:

- To assist with planned project works nationally.
- You'll be in a position where you can work and stay away from home either in a sleeper cab or hotel.
- You'll be able to load equipment and consumables required for delivering a successful project.
- You'll be able to carry out the required vehicle checks.
